DOJ Objective: Use of Force

DOJ Recommendation #: 20.4

The SFPD should identify a research partner to further refine its use of force data collection and to explore the data findings to this report to identify appropriate data for measurement and to determine casual factors.

Purpose:

A memorandum has been written by Sgt. Youngblood which requests that the SFPD partner with Chicago University. Chicago University has worked with other law enforcement agencies and analyzed their early intervention data in order to improve not only the Early Intervention System but the entire process of helping to identify officers more accurately who are prone to at-risk behavior.

Policy:

Sgt. Youngblood's memo was forwarded through the chain of command and has been approved and forwarded to our Fiscal Department where it will be reviewed for approval. The memorandum will then be sent to the City Attorney's Office. Once approved, SFPD will work with the Mayor's Office in order to apply for a grant through the Arnold Foundation which will assist with the cost of having the University of Chicago study our current EIS system as well as our indicators which include Use of Force.
